Responsibilities and Duties

- Diagnose all service related problems for apparatus customers
- Determine vehicle conditions by conducting inspections and diagnostic tests; identifying worn and damaged parts
- Read and interpret diagnostic test results from diagnostic equipment
- Inspect and verify dimensions and clearances of parts to ensure conformance to factory specifications
- Inspect, repair, and maintain automotive and mechanical equipment and machinery, such as pumps and compressors
- Recondition and replace parts, pistons, bearings, gears, breaks and valves
- Adjust brakes, align wheels, tighten bolts and screws, and reassemble equipment
- Complete scheduled preventative maintenance on trucks, such as hose testing, pump testing and ladder testing
- Assist with or complete repairs such as leaks and pump packing
- Verify vehicle performance by conducting driving tests; adjusting controls and systems
- Keep job knowledge updated by participating in continued training and educational opportunities
- Install equipment on new apparatus prior to delivery

Qualifications and Skills

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must be able to pass a criminal background check and pre-employment drug screen
- Must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record; CDL Class B driver's license or ability to obtain one is preferred
- Must be able to receive and maintain a valid Certified Medical Examiner's Health Certificate
- Knowledge of machines and tools including their designs, uses, benefits, repairs and maintenance
- Must be able to work in adverse weather conditions, such as outside in the rain, cold, heat, humidity, etc.
- Must be able to work in noisy environments, around engines and apparatus'
- Must be able to bend or stoop, kneel and climb ladders for long periods of time; must also be able to lift up to 50 lbs., approximately 10% of the day
- Must be able to drive in a vehicle for extended amounts of time in between job sites
- Must be able to travel overnight occasionally
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule and varying work hours
- Three plus years' diesel mechanic experience preferred
- ASE and EVT certifications preferred
- Electrical, A/C and diagnostic experience preferred
